On September 25, 2014 Governor Brown signed into law Assembly Bill (AB) 52, a bill that amended CEQA to mandate consultation with California Native American tribes during the CEQA process as of July 1, 2015. She serves as Cultural Resources Manager for ECORP Consulting, Inc., designing and carrying out cultural resources investigations and programs to support Section 106 NHPA consultations and environmental review under CEQA. Ms. Westwood was asked by attorneys from the California Building Industry Association and the California Chamber of Commerce to comment on the draft AB 52 bill. After AB 52 was signed, she met with OPR attorneys to discuss implementation of the bill. Building upon her expertise in archaeology and cultural resources law, and her experience in CEQA/NEPA, permitting, and tribal consultation, her professional focus is on cultural resources policy and the negotiation and development of cultural resources compliance strategy for large specific plans, residential developments, and public sector projects. She is also a member of the Department of Anthropology faculty at California State University-Chico and Butte College.
